# SUPPLEMENT NARRATIVE

AFTER RECEIVING THIS CASE AS A WORK CASE I CONTACTED THE GENERAL MANAGER CHUCK BURNSIDE AND HE REQUESTED THAT I COME TO THE LOCATION AND DISCUSS THIS CASE. WE CARPENTER AND RAMSEY WENT TO THE LOCATION AND MET WITH BURNSIDE AND THE REPAIR TEE LAUER AND THE OWNER LARRY GERDES. THEY FEEL THAT AN EX-GAURD SERVICE EMPLOYEE MIGHT BE INVOLVED. DAVID WORDEN WM 20S WITH WORDEN SECURITY WAS SEEN ON THE CO MPLS PROPERTY BY SECURITY GUARD JOHN GONZALES WHO SUPPOSEDLY TALKED TO WORDEN AT 3:00 AM FOR 5 OR 10 MINUTES ON THE DAY OF THE BURGLARY. GONZALES SUPPOSEDLY TALKED TO WORDEN ON THE NORTH PARKING LOT AND THEN WATCHED WORDEN GO OUT THE FRONT OF THE BUSINESS AND GO NEXT DOOR WHERE HE WAS WORKING AT THE SAME TIME FOR THE CRYSLER DEALER NEXT DOOR. DURING THE CONFERENCE THEY RELATED THAT THEY HAVE BEEN HAVING A LOT OF THEFTS AND AUTO THEFTS AND FEEL THEY HAVE AN INTERNAL SECURITY PROBLEM. THEY STATED THAT THEY HAVE BEEN POLYGRAPHING EMPLOYEES WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS. THEY ALSO STATED THAT MOST OF THE EMPLOYEES OF WORDEN SECURITY HAVE ALSO BEEN POLYGRAPHED WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS, INCLUDING DAVID. MR BURNSIDE TOOK US ON A TOUR OF THE SERVICE DEPT AND SHOWED US WHERE THE COMPUTER WAS TURNED OFF AND A DOOR DAMAGED. HE ALSO SHOWED US A WINDOW IN THE CUSTOMER WAITING AREA WHERE HE BELIEVES ENTRY WAS GAINED. AN INSPECTION DID NOT SHOW ANY FORCED ENTRY.

DURING THE CONVERSATION WITH THE OWNER SHOWED THAT HE INTENDS TO POST A \$25,000 REWARD FOR INFORMATION ON THIS CASE AND THE CONTINUING AUTO THEFT PROBLEM THEY HAVE BEEN HAVING. I COUNSELED HIM TO CONTACT MPD CRIME STOPPERS FOR ADVICE IN ADMINISTERING THIS REWARD.

I ALSO TALKED TO ROLAND CONTRERAS OWNER OF THE CURRENT GAURD SERVICE 937 13 AM. D. ASKED HIM TO HAVE THE GUARD ON DUTY AT THE TIME OF THIS OFFENSE JOHN GONZALES CONTACT ME IN REGARD TO HIS CONVERSATION WITH WORDEN. INVESTIGATION TO CONTINUE.
